MINUTE ORDER. Upon consideration of the parties' joint status report and the representations of the parties at the status conferences held on May 10 and May 25, 2017, and for the reasons stated on the record in open court at those conferences, the Court ORDERS defendants to review and process the approximately 11,000 pages of records identified by the Department of Health and Human Services and the 2,348 documents identified by the Office of Management and Budget by no later than September 5, 2017. HHS shall review and process (1) at least 3,500 pages by June 30, 2017; (2) at least an additional 3,500 pages by July 31, 2017; (3) and any remaining pages by September 5, 2017. HHS shall produce any non-exempt, responsive material to plaintiff on a rolling basis on those same dates. OMB shall review and process (1) at least 775 documents by June 30, 2017; (2) at least an additional 775 documents by July 31, 2017; (3) and any remaining documents by September 5, 2017. OMB shall produce any non-exempt, responsive material to plaintiff on a rolling basis on those same dates. The Court FURTHER ORDERS the parties to comply with the following briefing schedule: defendants shall file their motion for summary judgment by no later than September 19, 2017; plaintiff shall file a combined cross-motion for summary judgment and opposition to defendants' motion for summary judgment, by no later than October 3, 2017; defendants shall file a combined reply in support of their motion for summary judgment and opposition to plaintiff's cross-motion by no later than October 17, 2017; and plaintiff shall file a reply in support of its cross-motion by no later than October 23, 2017.
