Dear Public Information Manager Wynn:

Pursuant to the Kentucky Open Records Act (KORA), codified at KRS §§ 61.870 et seq., please find below a request for records.

**Requested Records**

**Statement of Noncommercial Purpose**

This request is for noncommercial purposes, and I respectfully request a waiver of any fees associated with processing this request for records. To the extent any fees are charged, pursuant to KRS § 61.874(3), I ask that such fees be limited to the actual cost of reproduction and exclude the cost of agency staff time.

This request is primarily and fundamentally for non-commercial purposes. I seek the records requested to inform the public regarding Kentucky's congressional redistricting process, which is a subject of considerable public interest.<sup>1</sup> Records with the potential to shed light on this matter would contribute significantly to public understanding of operations of the government, including whether and to what extent Kentucky's redistricting leaders have communicated with Kentucky's congressional delegation.

**Guidance Regarding the Search & Processing of Requested Records**

In connection with its request for records, please find below guidance regarding the scope of the records sought and the search and processing of records:

- Please search all locations and systems likely to have responsive records.

- This request for records includes any attachments to those records or other materials enclosed with those records when they were previously transmitted. To the extent that an email is responsive to our request, this request includes all prior messages sent or received in that email chain, as well as any attachments to the email.
- Please search all relevant records or systems containing records regarding agency business. Do not exclude records regarding agency business contained in files, email accounts, or devices in the personal custody of your officials, such as personal email accounts or text messages.
- In the event some portions of the requested records are properly exempt from disclosure, please disclose any reasonably segregable non-exempt portions of the requested records. *See* KRS § 61.878(4). If a request is denied in whole, please state specifically why it is not reasonable to segregate portions of the record for release.
- Please take appropriate steps to ensure that records responsive to this request are not deleted by the agency before the completion of processing for this request. If records potentially responsive to this request are likely to be located on systems where they are subject to potential deletion, including on a scheduled basis, please take steps to prevent that deletion, including, as appropriate, by instituting a litigation hold on those records.

If you have any questions regarding how to construe this request for records or believe that further discussions regarding search and processing would facilitate a more efficient production of records of interest, please do not hesitate to contact me to discuss this request. I welcome an opportunity to discuss this request with you before you undertake your search or incur search or duplication costs. By working together at the outset, we can decrease the likelihood of costly and time-consuming litigation in the future.
